

Requirements and testing procedures for the LPCB approval and listing of intruder resistant building components, strong points, security enclosures and free-standing barriers.

The Loss Prevention Certification Board (LPCB) is an internationally recognised certification body offering approvals of fire and security products and services.

This standard describes tests for classifying the intruder resistance of building components, strong points, security enclosures and free standing barriers; in the case of doors it includes all hardware including locks, cylinders and hinges.

It has 8 classes of security which are intended to address the levels of attack associated with the casual opportunist to the experienced professional burglar.

Manual intervention/physical attack testing is used with a set tool list within a set time limit to assess the security class of the doorset.

The general vulnerability of hardware using all known attack methods will be assessed therefore it is important to select quality products to successfully achieve the class required.
